- 24,081 square kilometers

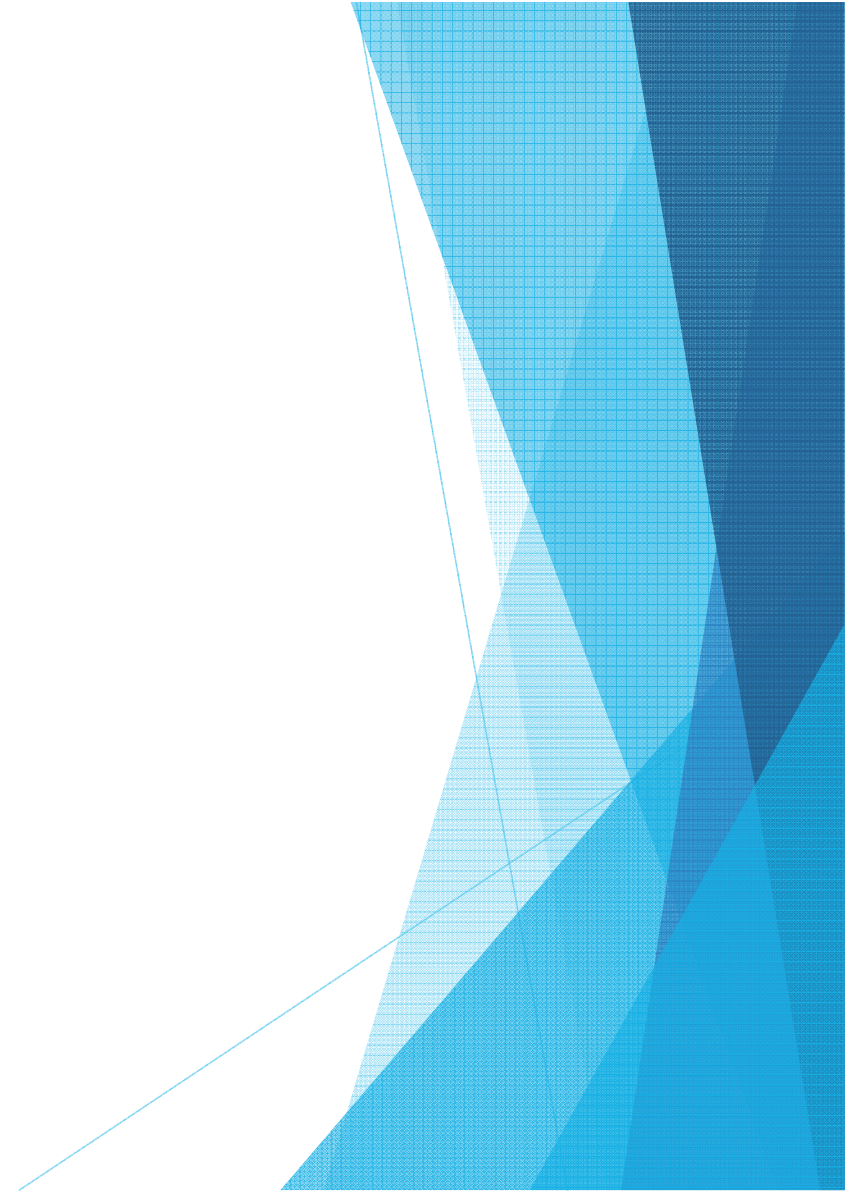
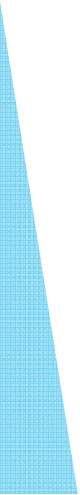
# Student Support Services in NWSO

- ▶ SLPs: 5.0 FTE: 1.5 in Marshall and 3.5 in Meadow Lake
- ▶ Explanation of driving time taken into account as well. Caseloads range from 77-171.
- ▶ OTs: 2.0 FTE: 1.0 in Marshall and 1.0 in Meadow Lake
- ▶ Work with approximately 15% of our students. Priority is Pre K-grade 3

# Life Skills Groups

- ▶ Three locations: Neilburg, Turtleford and Meadow Lake (JSJH and CHS)
- ▶ Every second week
- ▶ SLP and OT collaboration to work on specific skills (budgeting, cooking, hygiene, etc.)

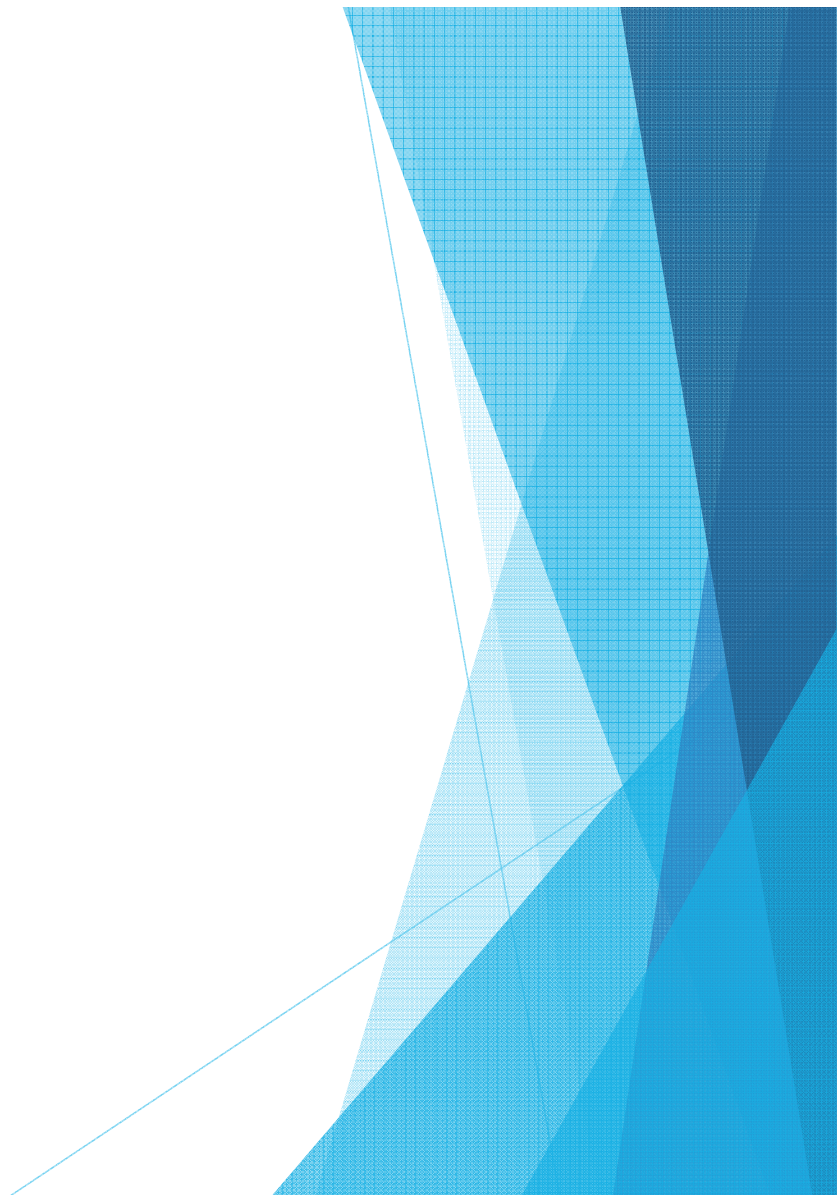
# Jubilee Fun Day



# Communication Camp

- ▶ Once a month for approximately two hours
- ▶ Occurs in Meadow Lake and Turtleford
- ▶ SLP and OT directed centers with EA/parent-student pairings
- ▶ Different vocabulary targeted each month
- ▶ Different activities such as books, scavenger hunts, games, and crafts are completed each camp
- ▶ Homework packages sent back to school for the EA and student to work on between camps

## LEGO Rules
