Curriculum-making is an intentional act of organizing, designing, developing, and assessing outcomes/objectives of learning experiences in subject areas. Planning for instruction occurs through the interaction of educators, learners, contexts and provincial curricula, including ELA, Social Studies, Mathematics, Practical and Applied Arts, Sciences, Fine Arts, and Physical Education. Considerations for planning, intellectual practice, assessment, and building learning experiences will be aspects of this course, with a focus on lesson and unit planning. Culturally responsive instruction, technology, questioning, and planning for exceptionalities will be featured topics to support Teacher Candidates in thinking about the planning cycle.
